The Greater Huntsville Pastors Prayer Summit gathering is open to all Christian leaders (parachurch ministries, Christian counselors, church staff ministers) and pastors throughout the greater Huntsville area. The Greater Huntsville Pastors Prayer Summit movement is not a ministerial association, but is a fellowship committed to praying for spiritual renewal and awakening in both the local church and surrounding community. Out of the realization that no one local fellowship can reach an entire city, our prayer is for God to “fan into flame” His presence, Word, and very life of Jesus Christ through a critical mass of local churches throughout the city and region, in the ultimate hope of seeing the multitudes in the greater Huntsville region come to a “saving” knowledge and experience of Jesus Christ as Messiah and Lord.

The Greater Huntsville Pastors Prayer Summit is not a reflection of the old ecumenicalism of the 60’s and 70’s.
